Theory Programs

The theory topics comprise: Safety fundamentals for crane operators; introduction to crane certification process; crane operation knowledge; rigging knowledge; crane rigging charts; communications knowledge; load chart knowledge; crane service and maintenance and crane pre-trip inspections & set-u.

Practical Programs

The crane training school comprises practical training including hands-on learning. This part teaches trainees how to identify crane terminology and components. Trainees would have the chance to perform skills considered necessary for crane operating, signaling and rigging.

Practical course topics: Identify crane functions and components; Learn crane terminology; utilize remote control; identify rigging and wire ropes; identify regulations and documents for rigging and wire rope; pre-use inspection on crane; use hand signals and radio; perform right lifting and lowering of loads and carry out rigging methods.
