Introduction

It is necessary for the worker to transport and store the merchandise throughout the facility in a timely and efficient method. Due to the many activities involved within warehouse operations, employees in warehouse settings might be at greater risk for accidents than individuals who work in areas with more limited activities. Hence, businesses place a top priority on warehouse safety.

Knowledge of potential warehouse hazards is key to preventing accidents. Always be alert to potential dangers and ways to reduce risks. Do whatever is necessary to prevent accidents.

General Hazards

Common kinds of hazard in a warehouse environment are trips, falls and slips. These accidents are normally caused when employees lose their balance or stumble over an item which has not been put away properly. Placing or removing items from storage can result in a slip or fumble, potentially causing both thing and worker to fall. The potential for falls, slips and trips is increased when workers are moving supplies on different kinds of floor surfaces and on different levels. Another common danger is getting hit by falling objects. This is normally caused by failure to correctly stack items on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries due to improper lifting methods are another common hazard.

There are inherent risks in utilizing and working around workplace machinery. Accidents may normally be caused from the improper utilization of hand trucks, forklift trucks and conveyors. Warehouse tools, like skids, pallets, cutting and strapping tools, should be used cautiously during unpacking, packing and loading.

Hazardous substances, flammable or combustible materials can pose hazards while being stored in a warehouse. Staff should know how to take steps to protect themselves from health dangers when working around hazardous materials.
